

All Group companies and their employees are committed to meet the following objectives:

6. to actively encourage and promote responsible behaviours, to protect and safeguard the environment, in particular focusing on energy efficiency, reduction of CO₂ emissions, use of sustainable resources and responsible waste management;
7. to establish appropriate KPIs and associated targets to measure and periodically assess the achievement of health, safety and environmental protection objectives, identifying potential areas of improvement.
8. to consult and co-operate with workers' representatives, trade unions, industry bodies and authorities, in order to continuously enhance health & safety and environmental protection performance;
9. to identify and collaborate with customers, suppliers, external partners and stakeholders, who share the same health & safety and environmental protection values and objectives;
